# CLINICAL ROTATIONS II

### 1. CONTACT HOURS:

Practical - 9 h Seminars - 3 h Tutorials - 4 h Total - 16 h

### 2. OBJECTIVES:

To continue student's exposure to "real" clinical cases at the Veterinary Teaching Hospital (VTH); to develop a set of attitudes adjusted to work in a hospital environment; to improve oral communication skills and teamwork; to promote organizational abilities as well as to incur liabilities.

### 3. PROGRAMME:

Clinical Rotations II takes place from Monday to Thursday in 3-hour periods at the Faculty Hospital. The activities are planned for groups of 6 students. Each group must accomplish 2 periods of 3 hours per semester resulting on 6 hours/student/semester.

The 6 students in each group will be subdivided into two groups of 3 students who will assist one VTH clinician.

Clinical Rotations II also take place from Monday to Friday at the Infectious Diseases Isolation Unit of VTH (IDIU) for groups of 4 students. Each student must complete a period of 3 hours at IDIU.

Students will keep up with teachers, practitioners, nurses and trainees activities and will perform basic procedures such as: (i) lead owners and animals to the consultation rooms; (ii) animal weighing; (iii) place pets on the examination table; (iv) animal handling; (v) body temperature reading; (vi) transport of biological samples to specific diagnosis laboratories; (vii) guide animal owners to the VTH Reception; (viii) computer update of individual clinical files; (ix) develop communication skills with client and with all the professionals working at the VTH. To this end, they will attend the 2<sup>nd</sup> Communication Module for Veterinarians, which will be constituted by three 1-hour seminars and will perform theatricalized simulations of anamnesis in the VTH (tutorials).

## 4. ASSESSMENT:

Each student is assessed according to the following criterion:

**1.** A written exam. Topics to assess will be those discussed at the seminars plus a short list of scientific papers;

2. It is required 100% assiduity on VTH and IDIU shifts;

**3.** Each absence in a seminar will penalize 0.5 values in the mark obtained in the final exam.
