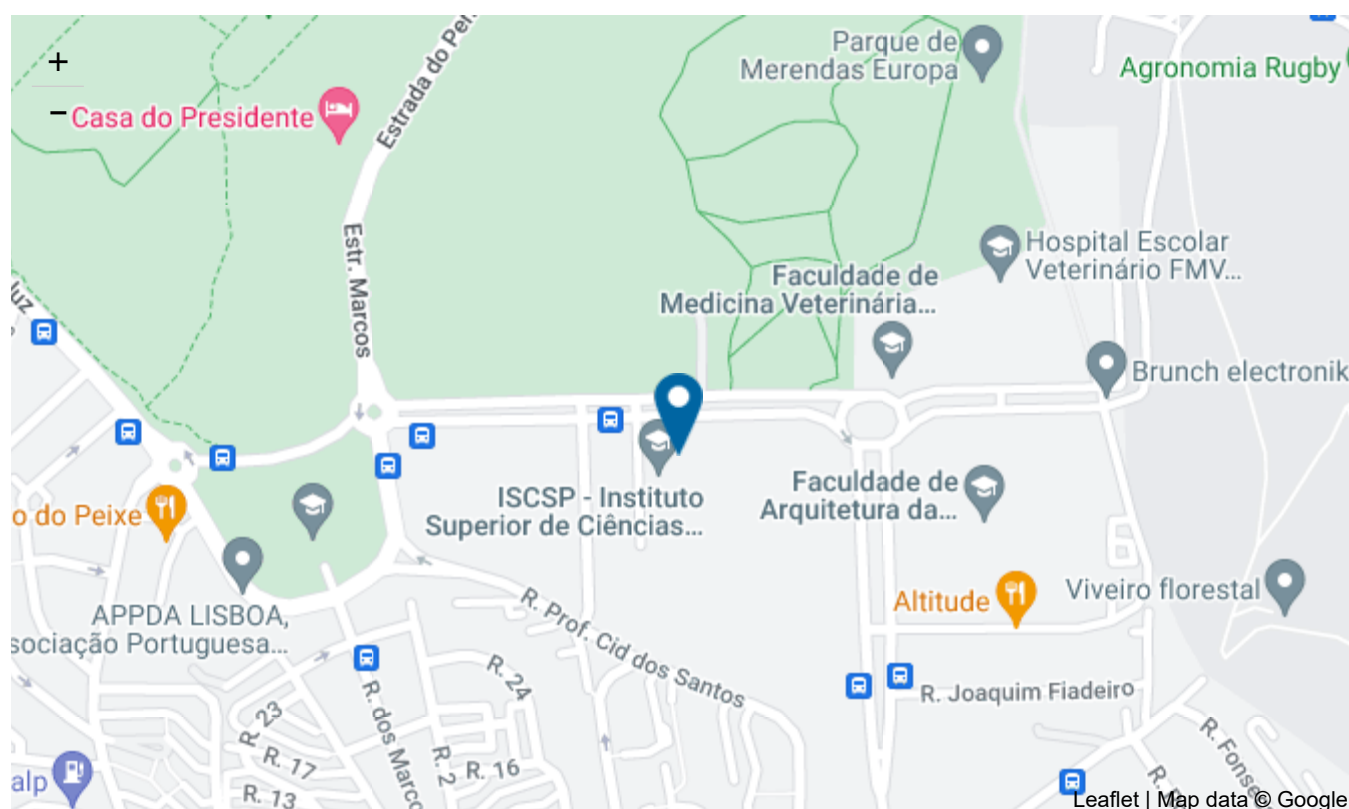
- a) Modulating germinal centres via TLR2
