Applications are invited, for a period of 30 days following the date of publication of the present notice in the Diário da República (Official Journal), for one (1) position of Auxiliary Professor in the disciplinary area of Clinics, to be hired by the Faculdade de Medicina Veterinária of the Universidade de Lisboa (Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Lisbon, FMV-ULisboa).
